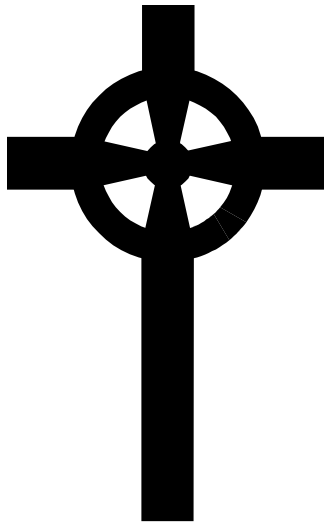
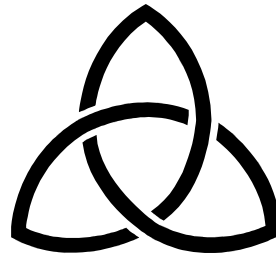
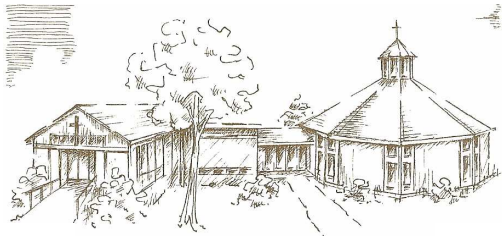

Welcome to Trinity Lutheran Church's **S**unday **C**hurch **S**chool (SCS)!

It's time to start another year of Sunday Church School for children ages 3 years old (as of 10/31/2011) through 6th grade. Attached is the 2011-2012 Registration Form. Please complete the form as soon as possible and return it to the church office **by September 1st**.

We are working together with our team of teachers, assistants, and special event coordinators preparing for our 2011-2012 season and praying for a wonderful year of learning, worship, and fellowship with our students. Your child's spiritual development and education is a priority. It is the church's privilege to assist you in fulfilling your baptismal promise to your child(ren) by providing this formal instruction in their Christian faith.

Rally Day will be held on **Sunday, September 11th** at the 9:00 AM Worship Service. Please join us at Coffee Hour in Fellowship Hall following the Worship service. SCS teachers will be available to answer questions. The SCS calendar will be available—please take a copy and note the many events that will occur throughout the SCS 2011-2012 season.

3rd Grade please note: You will be receiving your bibles **on Bible Sunday**, September 18th at the 9 AM Worship service. You and your parents (or adult guardian) will then participate together in a three week Bible program on 9/25, 10/2, 10/9; and return to the 9 AM Worship Service on 10/16 to share your Bible learnings with a game of Bible Jeopardy!

We need you to work together with us—as outlined in the SCS Parent Responsibilities form. Many parents stepped up and ran events for the first time this past year and did a fabulous job! Your participation enables flexibility within the program and also offers relief and support to the teaching staff involved in SCS the majority of the year. Consider how you can participate in this ministry and let us or the church office know you're available. **As of now several classes do not have a volunteer teacher in place;** therefore, parents will be scheduled to prepare and teach lessons on a rotating basis.

God requests all of us, through Word, Sacrament, and Holy Spirit, to bring Jesus into our lives daily. Prayerfully consider volunteering your time and work with the SCS Staff in some capacity. SCS Parent Responsibilities



As our children begin another year of study of their Christian faith in the Lutheran church, it is important that we as parents remind ourselves why Sunday Church School is so important and of the vows we took for them at their baptisms.

Please review the following points and initial each in the spaces provided to indicate that you agree to them. This form is to be returned with your child's SCS registration paperwork and payment. Please see Jeanette Baldanza or Lois Lawrence if you have any questions.

- _____ 1. Children are to be brought to the Sanctuary prior to 9:00 am on Sunday mornings. **Please be aware that a parent/guardian must be in the church building during the SCS hour—no drop offs or parking lot waiting, please.** Sunday worship is being held at the same time and your attendance is a great example for your children!
- _____ 2. **One parent per family is asked to sign up to assist with one of the major SCS events which take place during the year.** These include Advent Fest, Lent Event, Promotion Sunday, etc. A group of parents will sign up for each event and take care of one area of the event. Sign-ups will take place on **Rally Sunday**, which is **September 11, 2011**.
- _____ 3. Children have great energy. Our teachers understand and work with this love of life that our kids exhibit. **However, if a child is disruptive or hurtful to other students or the teachers, the child will be taken up to the Sanctuary to spend the Sunday Worship service with his/her parents. The child is welcome to join his/her SCS class the next week.** Please realize that bringing a child up to his/her parent(s) is a last resort and only comes after multiple chances have been given to the child to participate appropriately in class.
- _____ 4. Finally, here is a vow that we as parents took for our child/ren during the Sacrament of Holy Baptism. Please recommit to your child's faith as we enter another faith and fun-filled year on our journey with Christ.

In Christian love you have presented these children for Holy Baptism. You should faithfully bring them to the services of God's house, and teach them the Lord's Prayer, the Creed, and the Ten Commandments. As they grow in years, you should place in their hands the Holy Scriptures and provide for their instruction in the Christian faith, that, living in the covenant of their Baptism and in communion with the Church, they may lead godly lives until the day of Jesus Christ.
