DEVOTIONS

Think about devotions is as a continuation of our community's worship. The following basic pattern could be one way of forming your household's devotions. Adapt as necessary!

GATHERING

♣ Light a candle to help you focus this time as "God time."

Prayer of the Week

God of Power and Might—With your word, you gave us purpose. With your son, you gave us grace, mercy, and salvation. With your Spirit, you gave us life. Be with us this day from morning to night, and give us a willing and able spirit to share your love with those who we will meet today. Amen.

CARING CONVERSATION

Take a moment to check in with each other or to use the questions below.

- **Highs & Lows:** Name one thing you saw today that made happy. Name one thing you saw today that made you sad.
- Thinking About This Week's Story: Jesus ascends to heaven. But before he does, he sends out the disciples with the expectation that they will share God's love with others and tell his story of salvation. Name one way you will share God's love with others today.
- **Getting Ready for Next Week's Story:** Who in your office, class, or home is sick today? Say a prayer for healing for each person named.

DAILY BIBLE READING

Read aloud from the DAILY BIBLE READING from the front. What do you want to remember from this reading?

PRAY TOGETHER

♣ Hold each other's hands. Pray together either silently or aloud, and end with "Amen!"

CLOSING

If you used a candle, extinguish it as a sign of the end of the devotion time.

Prituals & Traditions: A Blessing to Share

Mark one another with the sign of the cross on each other's hands or forehead, and say, "Your God commissions you to be a disciple of Christ and to share God's love with all people."
