Think about devotions as a continuation of our community's worship. The following basic pattern could be one way of forming your household's devotions. Adapt as necessary!

GATHERING

♣ Light a candle to help you focus this time as "God time."

† Prayer of the Week

Almighty God, you always keep your promises as you did with David. You provided a son of David to sit on the throne of you kingdom forever: Jesus Christ. Help us to trust in your love and your promises to us. Amen.

CARING CONVERSATION

Take a moment to check in with each other or to use the questions below.

- P Highs and Lows: Name one thing that happened today that was easy. Name one thing that happened that was hard.
- Thinking About This Week's Story: David wanted to build a nice house for God to show his love and thanks. What is something you have done today to show someone else love or thanks? How has someone shown you love or thanks?
- **Getting Ready for Next Week's Story:** God brought Elijah to Zarephath to help a widow and her son. Who have you helped today? Who has helped you?

DAILY BIBLE READING

Read aloud from the DAILY BIBLE READING from the front. What do you want to remember from this reading?

PRAY TOGETHER

→ Starting with the youngest person in the room, pray for one thing that concerns each person.

CLOSING

♣ If you used a candle, extinguish it as a sign of the end of the devotion time.

Pilling Rituals & Traditions: A Blessing to Share

Mark one another with the sign of the cross on the forehead or hand, and say, "God will love you always. Amen."
