DEVOTIONS

Think about devotions as a continuation of our community's worship. The following basic pattern could be one way of forming your household's devotions. Adapt as necessary!

GATHERING

♣ Light a candle to help you focus this time as "God time."

Beloved Teacher, you love us as you loved your Son, Jesus. As Jesus desired to spend time in your house and learn about you, so too give us the desire to devote time to learn about you. Amen.

CARING CONVERSATION

Take a moment to check in with each other or to use the questions below.

- P Highs and Lows: Name one thing that went well today. Name one thing that did not go well.
- Thinking About This Week's Story: Jesus stayed behind to learn from the teachers at the temple. What is one thing you learned today, on any subject?
- Getting Ready for Next Week's Story: John the Baptist tells the people to turn around and live God's way. What is one good or helpful thing you did today? What is one thing you should have done, but did not (or did, but should not have done)?

DAILY BIBLE READING

Read aloud from the DAILY BIBLE READING from the front. What do you want to remember from this reading?

PRAY TOGETHER

[⊕] Hold hands and form a circle. One person begins the prayer, and when they are
done then they squeeze the hand of the next person. Continue until each person
has had a chance to pray.

CLOSING

₱ If you used a candle, extinguish it as a sign of the end of the devotion time.

P Rituals & Traditions: A Blessing to Share

Mark one another with the sign of the cross on each other's hands or forehead, and say, "Go and share God's love. Amen."
