Pray: Light a candle and open your devotion time with a prayer.

God of light, you sent Jesus to shine your love into our world. May your love shine through us to bring hope and peace to your world. Amen.



Read: Read the key verse from Sunday's reading.

"I am the light of the world" (John 8:12)



Reflect: Reflect on the scripture summary.

God created all the lights in the universe and also made us responsible for taking care of all of God's creation. Jesus pointed to God the Father as the source of all life and light.



Connect: Connect in conversation with others in your household.

What was a high point in your day? What was a low point?

What are different items that we use for light? How many do you have in your home?

How do you take care of these lights?

For the littles: When the lights go out, where do you think God is?



Bless: Close your devotion with a blessing.
