As we look to expanding the leadership of this mission, we are offering a breakdown in the roles for the shelter. Today we are highlighting the role of:

Volunteer Coordinator insures that there are volunteers to fill all the needed slots during the weeks that Trinity hosts the shelter. They are: Dinner Cook, Meal Server and Overnight Host. We utilize "Sign-up Genius", an online program, for volunteers to sign up. For those who aren't computer savvy, the Volunteer Coordinator can sign up for them. This coordinator keeps track so that all the slots are filled, sometimes needing to contact pervious folks to fill in as needed. You don't need to come down to the shelter to do this. The function can be performed from anywhere in the world where you have internet access. The Volunteer Coordinator then contacts the Kitchen Host and Greeter to let them know who is filling each slot each night.

Prayerfully consider how you might serve in this important ministry. We are asking only for a one year commitment.

HEALTH MINISTRY: There are times when conversations, thoughts and a variety of experiences come together and begin to percolate with ideas. In talking with a member about an idea to help advocate and help people when they are hospitalized, along with an event that I attended about Music & Memory, the number of people in medical fields in the congregation, prayer shawl ministry, and my home congregation's Healing ministry, I have been thinking that we might gather people together that could brainstorm ways in which we could enter into this kind of ministry here.
