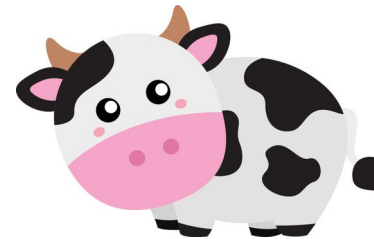


**BREWSTER CARES SHELTER:**
