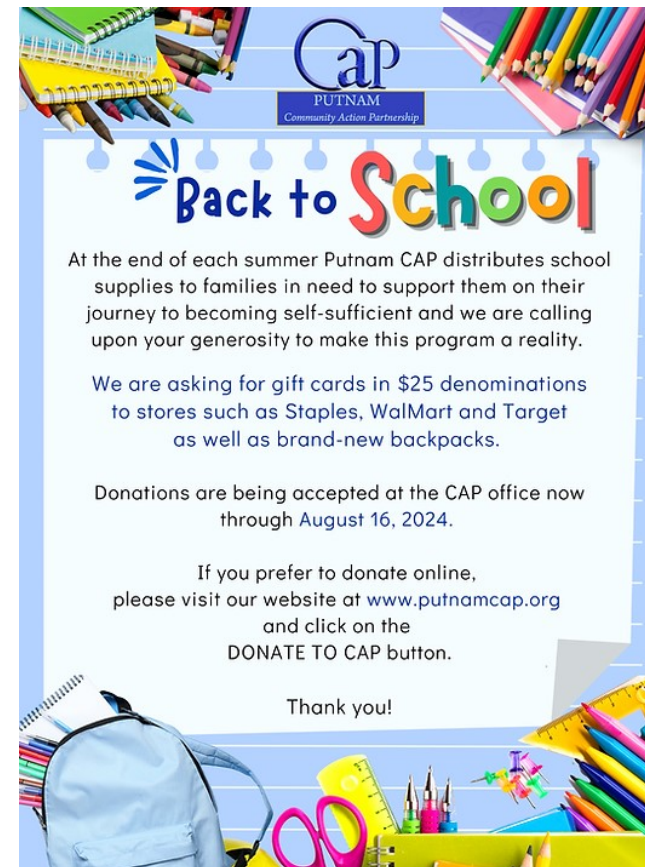
### **LUTHERAN WORLD RELIEF BABY KIT COLLECTION**

Some of the items most needed for the kits are cloth flat fold Gerber diapers, tee shirts in size 6 months to 24 months, sleepers or jumpsuit without feet size 6 months to 24 months. We do not need more homemade blankets at this time as a friend of the congregation has made 60 for us. I put a basket in the narthex for people to put items in I will have copies of the list of items needed for the kits and suggestions of where to get some of the items on the table in the narthex.
