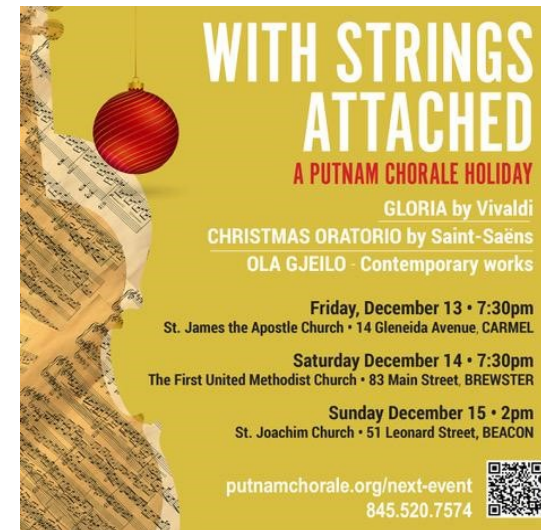
SEAFARER'S CHRISTMAS-AT-SEA
